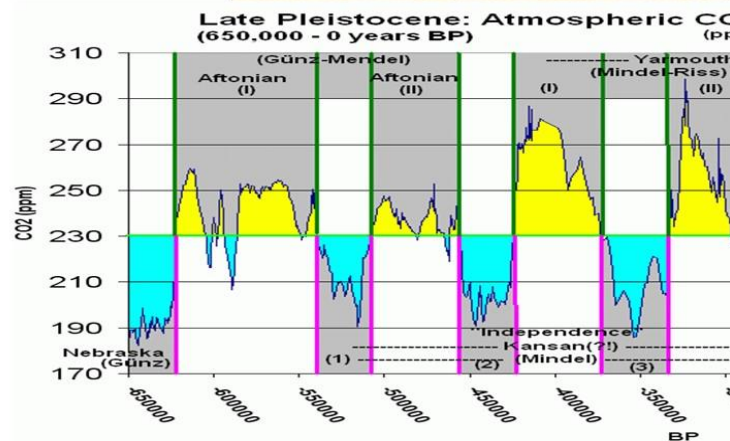


THE MOLE VALLEY GEOLOGICAL SOCIETY
